Playoff Scoring System:

* The scoring system for the playoffs is as follows:

- 2 points awarded for each win.
- 1 point awarded for each tie.
- 0 points awarded for each loss.
- If a blowout occurs, the winning team will not be given any credit for the game. Zero points will be awarded.
- If a player, coach, or spectator is ejected from a game, 1 point will be deducted

From the teams total points for each ejection.

After all playoff games are completed, the order of finish will be determined by totaling all the points awarded (and subtracted).

In the event of a tie between 1st, 2nd, and/or 3rd place the following tie breaker scheme will be applied until a winner is determined:

1. Most wins
2. Head to head (applies to a 2-way tie only)
3. Overall differential of goals for vs. goals against.
4. Total goals against.
5. Record vs. common opponents.
6. Differential of goals for vs. goals against vs. common opponents.
7. Goals against vs. common opponents.
8. Bonus points. Bonus points are used as the final tiebreaker only. Bonus points are awarded for the following:
 - 2 points for each shut-out.
 - 1 point for each goal scored (maximum 3 per game).

Note: Points and tie breakers only consider play-off games. Regular season statistics are not applied.

One other new policy to note is that at the end of the season. In lieu of trophies, All players will be awarded medals. Players on the teams that finish if 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in the playoffs will receive gold, silver and bronze colored medals. All other players will receive participation medals.
