Tie Breaker Rules:

Scoring: 2 points/win, 1 point/tie, Zero points awarded if blowout occurs (a blowout is defined as a win by more than 6 goals)

In the event of a tie the following tie breaker scheme will be applied until a winner is determined:

1. Most wins
2. Head to head (applies to a 2-way tie only)
3. Total goals against
4. Overall differential of goals for vs. goals against.
5. Record vs. common opponents.
6. Goals against vs. common opponents.
7. Differential of goals for vs. goals against vs. common opponents.
8. Bonus points. Bonus points are used as the final tiebreaker only. Bonus points are awarded for the following:
 - 2 points for each shut-out.
 - 1 point for each goal scored (maximum 3 per game).

Note: Points and tie breakers only consider play-off games. Regular season statistics are not applied.
