

## THOMAS EDISON PARK - directions to field

### Directions to Thomas Edison Park from NJ Turnpike

Take NJ turnpike North or South to Exit 10. Follow signs to County Road 514 West towards Bonhamtown. Merge onto Woodbridge Ave (Rt. 514). Proceed to the fifth traffic light (about 2.3 miles - you will pass Raritan Center and then Middlesex County College on your left. At the fifth light turn LEFT onto Mill Road (the college campus will still be on your left). Continue about 1/2 mile (just past the traffic light) and turn LEFT into Thomas Edison Park (look for the "easy-to-miss" plaque designating the park entrance at ground level on your left). About 1/2 mile into park (past railroad tracks and police academy) turn LEFT at "Ball Fields" sign.

**For fields #2 and #3** look for fields straight ahead and parking on your right. 1st field is #2 (full size), 2nd field is #3 (division 5 - small sided).

**For fields #1 and #4** look for next "Ball Fields" sign and turn LEFT again. A short distance ahead turn RIGHT. Field #1 (full size) is on your right, field #4 (division 5 - small sided) is on your left, and parking is straight ahead.

**For field #5**, only large sided field on left hand side enclosed by chainlink fence and bleachers. **RULES for USE OF FIELD #5:** only players, coaches and game officials are allowed on the field. All spectators and supporters are restricted to the bleachers and must remain behind the fence. No chairs are allowed on the track. Dispose of all trash in the available trash cans.

### Directions to Thomas Edison Park from Garden State Parkway SOUTH

Take GSP South to EXIT 130, "Route 1 North/South" exit. Stay right and merge onto Route 1 South toward Trenton. Drive 2.7 miles (past Menlo Park Mall and Route 287) and exit at Bonhamtown/County Road 531 South (just after Metuchen exit) which merges onto Main Street going south towards Bonhamtown. About one mile ahead, Main St ends at a traffic light. Turn RIGHT onto Woodbridge Ave. Travel one mile (Middlesex County College will be on your left) to the third traffic light and turn LEFT onto Mill Road (the college campus will still be on your left). Continue about 1/2 mile (just past the traffic light) and turn LEFT into Thomas Edison Park (look for the "easy-to-miss" plaque designating the park entrance at ground level on your left). About 1/2 mile into park (past railroad tracks and police academy) turn LEFT at "Ball Fields" sign.

**For fields #2 and #3** look for fields straight ahead and parking on your right. 1st field is #2 (full size), 2nd field is #3 (division 5 - small sided).

**For fields #1 and #4** look for next "Ball Fields" sign and turn LEFT again. A short distance ahead turn RIGHT. Field #1 (full size) is on your right, field #4 (division 5 - small sided) is on your left, and parking is straight ahead.

**For field #5**, only large sided field on left hand side enclosed by chainlink fence and bleachers. **RULES for USE OF FIELD #5:** only players, coaches and game officials are allowed on the field. All spectators and supporters are restricted to the bleachers and must remain behind the fence. No chairs are allowed on the track. Dispose of all trash in the available trash cans.

### Directions to Thomas Edison Park from Garden State Parkway NORTH

Take GSP North to EXIT 127, "Route 440 East/I-287 North/Route 9" exit. Follow signs for Rt. 440 West / I-287 North. Follow instructions for Interstate 287 Northbound.

### Directions to Thomas Edison Park from Interstate 287 Northbound

From Route 287 North - exit at County Road 514 West towards Bonhamtown. Merge onto Woodbridge Ave (Rt. 514) staying in either of the 2 right hand lanes. Proceed to the fifth traffic light (about 2.3 miles - you will pass Raritan Center and then Middlesex County College on your left. At the fifth light turn LEFT onto Mill Road (the college campus will still be on your left). Continue about 1/2 mile (just past the traffic light) and turn LEFT into Thomas Edison Park (look for the "easy-to-miss" plaque designating the park entrance at ground level on your left). About 1/2 mile into park (past railroad tracks and police academy)

turn LEFT at "Ball Fields" sign.

**For fields #2 and #3** look for fields straight ahead and parking on your right. 1st field is #2 (full size), 2nd field is #3 (division 5 - small sided).

**For fields #1 and #4** look for next "Ball Fields" sign and turn LEFT again. A short distance ahead turn RIGHT. Field #1 (full size) is on your right, field #4 (division 5 - small sided) is on your left, and parking is straight ahead.

**For field #5**, only large sided field on left hand side enclosed by chainlink fence and bleachers. **RULES for USE OF FIELD #5:** only players, coaches and game officials are allowed on the field. All spectators and supporters are restricted to the bleachers and must remain behind the fence. No chairs are allowed on the track. Dispose of all trash in the available trash cans.

#### **Directions to Thomas Edison Park from Interstate 287 Southbound**

From Route 287 South - exit at County Road 531/US Route 1 South (Exit 1b). At top of ramp merge onto 531 South (also called Main St) toward Bonhamtown. About one mile ahead, Main St ends at a traffic light. Turn RIGHT onto Woodbridge Ave. Travel one mile (Middlesex County College will be on your left) to the third traffic light and turn LEFT onto Mill Road (the college campus will still be on your left). Continue about 1/2 mile (just past the traffic light) and turn LEFT into Thomas Edison Park (look for the "easy-to-miss" plaque designating the park entrance at ground level on your left). About 1/2 mile into park (past railroad tracks and police academy) turn LEFT at "Ball Fields" sign.

**For fields #2 and #3** look for fields straight ahead and parking on your right. 1st field is #2 (full size), 2nd field is #3 (division 5 - small sided).

**For fields #1 and #4** look for next "Ball Fields" sign and turn LEFT again. A short distance ahead turn RIGHT. Field #1 (full size) is on your right, field #4 (division 5 - small sided) is on your left, and parking is straight ahead.

**For field #5**, only large sided field on left hand side enclosed by chainlink fence and bleachers. **RULES for USE OF FIELD #5:** only players, coaches and game officials are allowed on the field. All spectators and supporters are restricted to the bleachers and must remain behind the fence. No chairs are allowed on the track. Dispose of all trash in the available trash cans.

#### **Directions to Thomas Edison Park from Route 1 Northbound**

Traveling north on Route 1 exit at Bonhamtown/County Road 531 South (shortly after BJ's and immediately before Route 287) which merges onto Main Street going south towards Bonhamtown. About one mile ahead, Main St ends at a traffic light. Turn RIGHT onto Woodbridge Ave. Travel one mile (Middlesex County College will be on your left) to the third traffic light and turn LEFT onto Mill Road (the college campus will still be on your left). Continue about 1/2 mile (just past the traffic light) and turn LEFT into Thomas Edison Park (look for the "easy-to-miss" plaque designating the park entrance at ground level on your left). About 1/2 mile into park (past railroad tracks and police academy) turn LEFT at "Ball Fields" sign.

**For fields #2 and #3** look for fields straight ahead and parking on your right. 1st field is #2 (full size), 2nd field is #3 (division 5 - small sided).

**For fields #1 and #4** look for next "Ball Fields" sign and turn LEFT again. A short distance ahead turn RIGHT. Field #1 (full size) is on your right, field #4 (division 5 - small sided) is on your left, and parking is straight ahead.

**For field #5**, only large sided field on left hand side enclosed by chainlink fence and bleachers. **RULES for USE OF FIELD #5:** only players, coaches and game officials are allowed on the field. All spectators and supporters are restricted to the bleachers and must remain behind the fence. No chairs are allowed on the track. Dispose of all trash in the available trash cans.

#### **Directions to Thomas Edison Park from Route 1 Southbound**

Traveling south on Route 1 pass Menlo Park Mall and Route 287, and exit at Bonhamtown/County Road 531 South (just after Metuchen exit) which merges onto Main Street going south towards Bonhamtown. About one mile ahead, Main St ends at a traffic light. Turn RIGHT onto Woodbridge Ave. Travel one mile (Middlesex County College will be on your left) to the third traffic light and turn LEFT onto Mill Road (the college campus will still be on your left). Continue about 1/2 mile (just past the traffic light) and turn LEFT into Thomas Edison Park (look for the "easy-to-miss" plaque designating the park entrance at ground

level on your left). About 1/2 mile into park (past railroad tracks and police academy) turn LEFT at "Ball Fields" sign.

**For fields #2 and #3** look for fields straight ahead and parking on your right. 1st field is #2 (full size), 2nd field is #3 (division 5 - small sided).

**For fields #1 and #4** look for next "Ball Fields" sign and turn LEFT again. A short distance ahead turn RIGHT. Field #1 (full size) is on your right, field #4 (division 5 - small sided) is on your left, and parking is straight ahead.

**For field #5**, only large sided field on left hand side enclosed by chainlink fence and bleachers. **RULES for USE OF FIELD #5:** only players, coaches and game officials are allowed on the field. All spectators and supporters are restricted to the bleachers and must remain behind the fence. No chairs are allowed on the track. Dispose of all trash in the available trash cans.

#### **Directions to Thomas Edison Park from Route 27 Northbound**

Coming from the direction of Highland Park on Route 27 North turn RIGHT at Plainfield Ave (just beyond Tops Appliance Plaza). Proceed to Route 1 and turn LEFT onto Route 1 North. Exit at Bonhamtown/County Road 531 South (shortly after BJ's and immediately before Route 287) which merges onto Main Street going south towards Bonhamtown. About one mile ahead, Main St ends at a traffic light. Turn RIGHT onto Woodbridge Ave. Travel one mile (Middlesex County College will be on your left) to the third traffic light and turn LEFT onto Mill Road (the college campus will still be on your left). Continue about 1/2 mile (just past the traffic light) and turn LEFT into Thomas Edison Park (look for the "easy-to-miss" plaque designating the park entrance at ground level on your left). About 1/2 mile into park (past railroad tracks and police academy) turn LEFT at "Ball Fields" sign.

**For fields #2 and #3** look for fields straight ahead and parking on your right. 1st field is #2 (full size), 2nd field is #3 (division 5 - small sided).

**For fields #1 and #4** look for next "Ball Fields" sign and turn LEFT again. A short distance ahead turn RIGHT. Field #1 (full size) is on your right, field #4 (division 5 - small sided) is on your left, and parking is straight ahead.

**For field #5**, only large sided field on left hand side enclosed by chainlink fence and bleachers. **RULES for USE OF FIELD #5:** only players, coaches and game officials are allowed on the field. All spectators and supporters are restricted to the bleachers and must remain behind the fence. No chairs are allowed on the track. Dispose of all trash in the available trash cans.

#### **Directions to Thomas Edison Park from Route 27 Southbound**

Coming from the direction of the Garden State Parkway toward Metuchen on Route 27 South, proceed to Main St in Metuchen and turn LEFT. Continue to the third traffic light (Main St ends) and turn RIGHT onto Woodbridge Ave. Travel one mile (Middlesex County College will be on your left) to the third traffic light and turn LEFT onto Mill Road (the college campus will still be on your left). Continue about 1/2 mile (just past the traffic light) and turn LEFT into Thomas Edison Park (look for the "easy-to-miss" plaque designating the park entrance at ground level on your left). About 1/2 mile into park (past railroad tracks and police academy) turn LEFT at "Ball Fields" sign.

**For fields #2 and #3** look for fields straight ahead and parking on your right. 1st field is #2 (full size), 2nd field is #3 (division 5 - small sided).

**For fields #1 and #4** look for next "Ball Fields" sign and turn LEFT again. A short distance ahead turn RIGHT. Field #1 (full size) is on your right, field #4 (division 5 - small sided) is on your left, and parking is straight ahead.

**For field #5**, only large sided field on left hand side enclosed by chainlink fence and bleachers. **RULES for USE OF FIELD #5:** only players, coaches and game officials are allowed on the field. All spectators and supporters are restricted to the bleachers and must remain behind the fence. No chairs are allowed on the track. Dispose of all trash in the available trash cans.

#### **Directions to Thomas Edison Park from Route 22**

Take US Route 22 to Route 287 South. Travel approx. 4.5 miles on Route 287 South. Exit at County Road 531/US Route 1 South (Exit 1b). At top of ramp merge onto 531 South (also called Main St) toward Bonhamtown. About one mile ahead, Main St ends at a traffic light. Turn RIGHT onto Woodbridge Ave. Travel one mile (Middlesex County College will be on your left) to the third traffic light and turn LEFT onto Mill Road (the college campus will still be on your left). Continue about 1/2 mile (just past the traffic light)

and turn LEFT into Thomas Edison Park (look for the "easy-to-miss" plaque designating the park entrance at ground level on your left). About 1/2 mile into park (past railroad tracks and police academy) turn LEFT at "Ball Fields" sign.

**For fields #2 and #3** look for fields straight ahead and parking on your right. 1st field is #2 (full size), 2nd field is #3 (division 5 - small sided).

**For fields #1 and #4** look for next "Ball Fields" sign and turn LEFT again. A short distance ahead turn RIGHT. Field #1 (full size) is on your right, field #4 (division 5 - small sided) is on your left, and parking is straight ahead.

**For field #5**, only large sided field on left hand side enclosed by chainlink fence and bleachers. **RULES for USE OF FIELD #5:** only players, coaches and game officials are allowed on the field. All spectators and supporters are restricted to the bleachers and must remain behind the fence. No chairs are allowed on the track. Dispose of all trash in the available trash cans.
